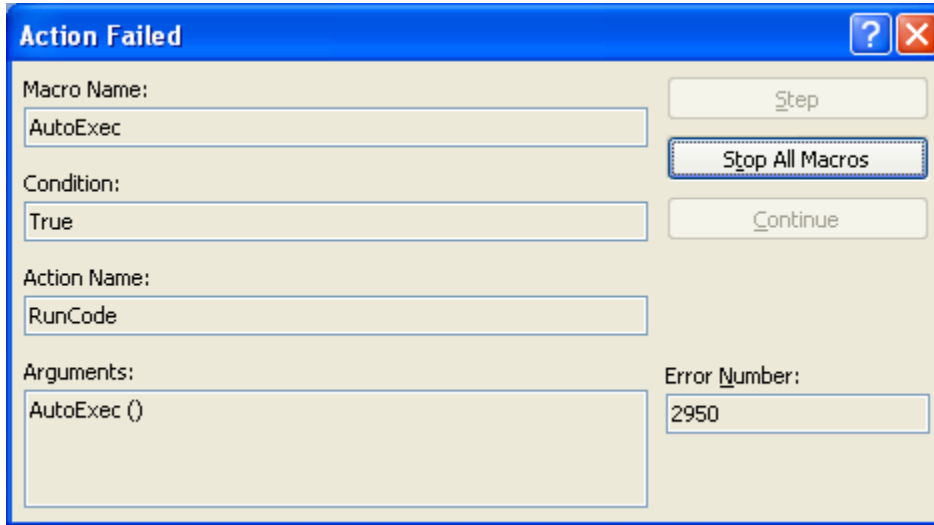


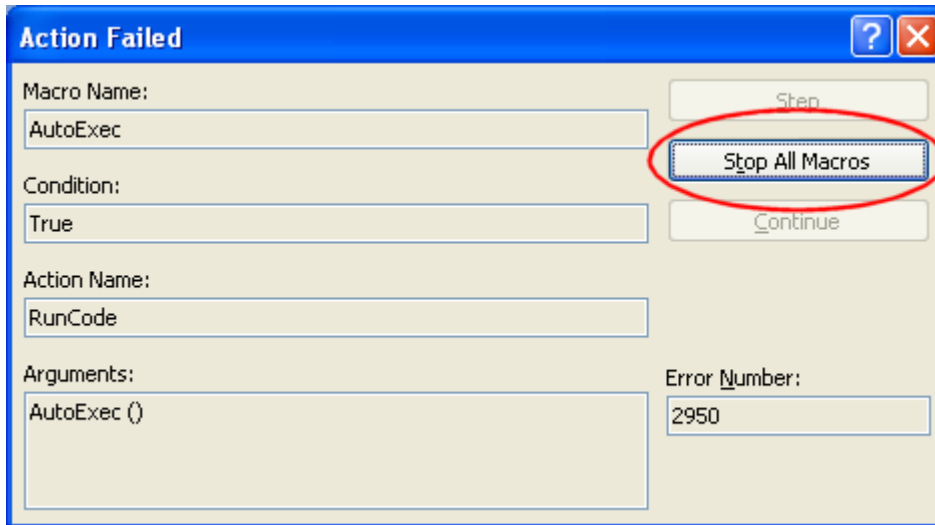
Allowing Parts Tracker to run with Office 2007 macro security

When you start Parts Tracker under Office 2007 you may get the following warning:

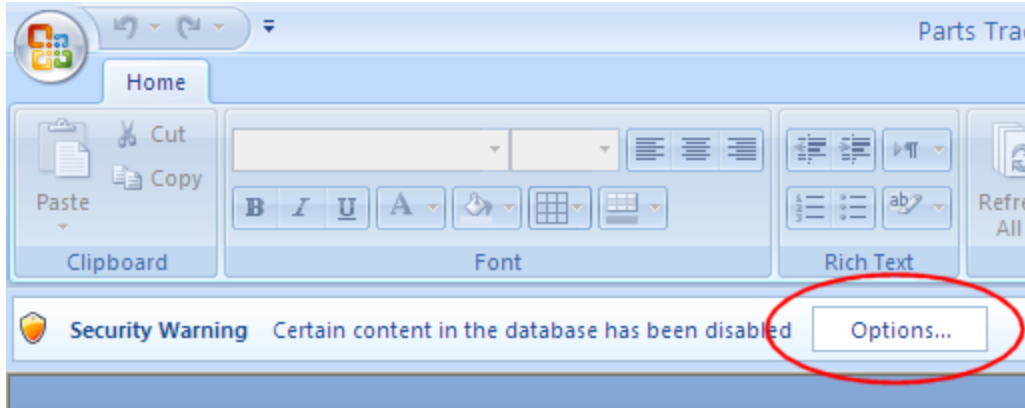


This is because by default, Parts Tracker is not a “trusted” Microsoft Access application and Office deems it potentially unsafe to run.

Press the **Stop All Macros** button to continue:

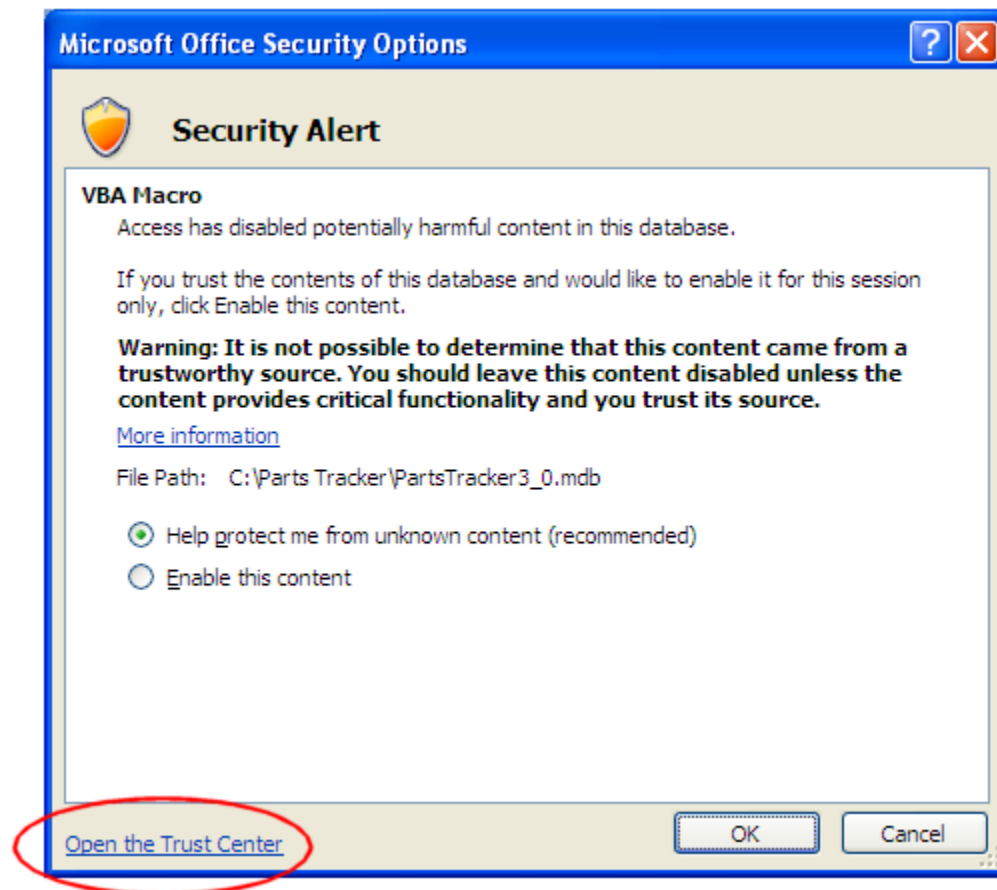


Access then opens and displays the following below the main ribbon:



Press the **Options** button.

The following dialog is displayed:

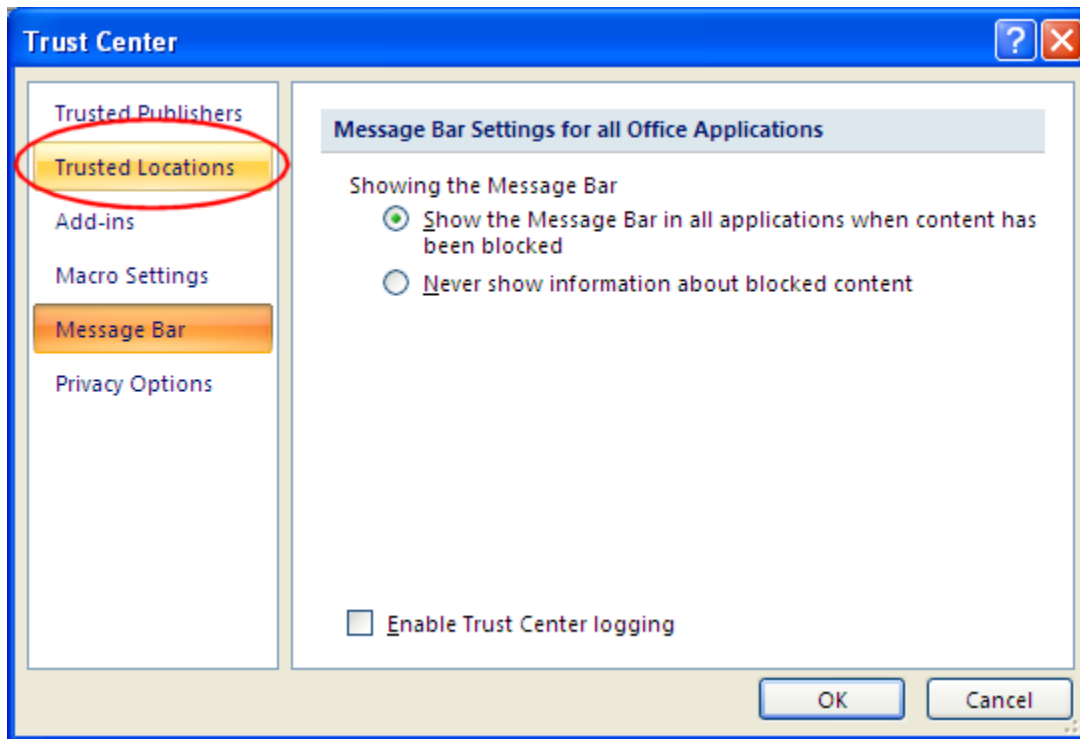


Note: at this point, you can select the **Enable this content** option and press **OK** to run Parts Tracker without adding it as a trusted application. This means the security alert will be displayed again when you next start Parts Tracker (and each time until you add Parts Tracker to the trusted locations list).

To add Parts Tracker to the Trusted Locations list:

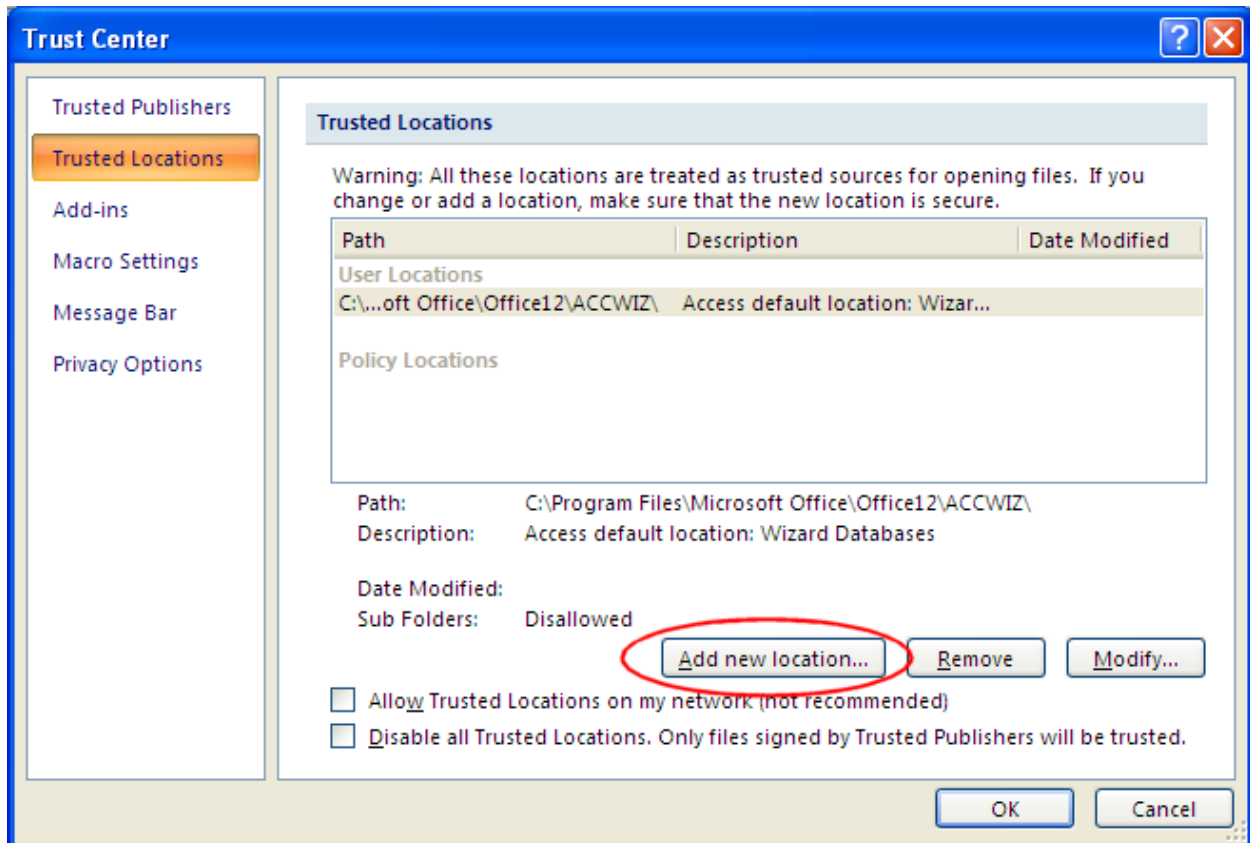
Press the **Open the Trust Center** link.

The Trust Center dialog opens:



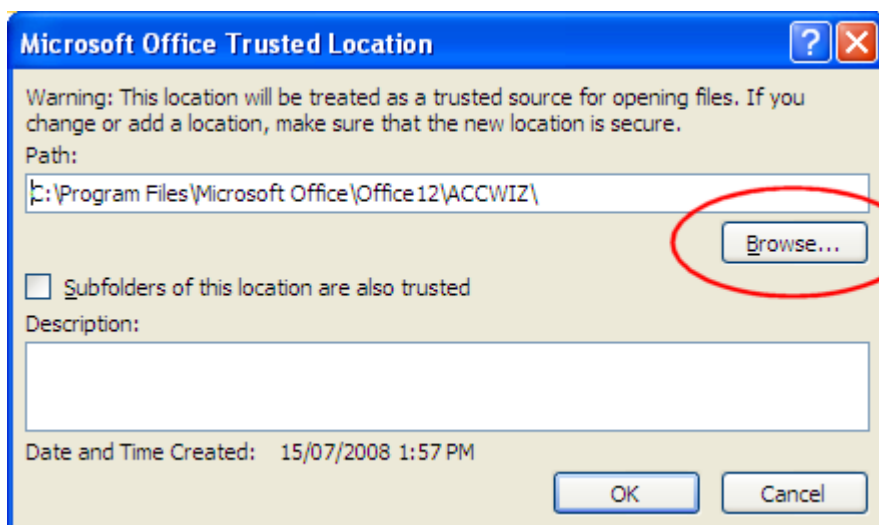
Press the **Trusted Locations** button in the left menu.

The trusted locations are listed:



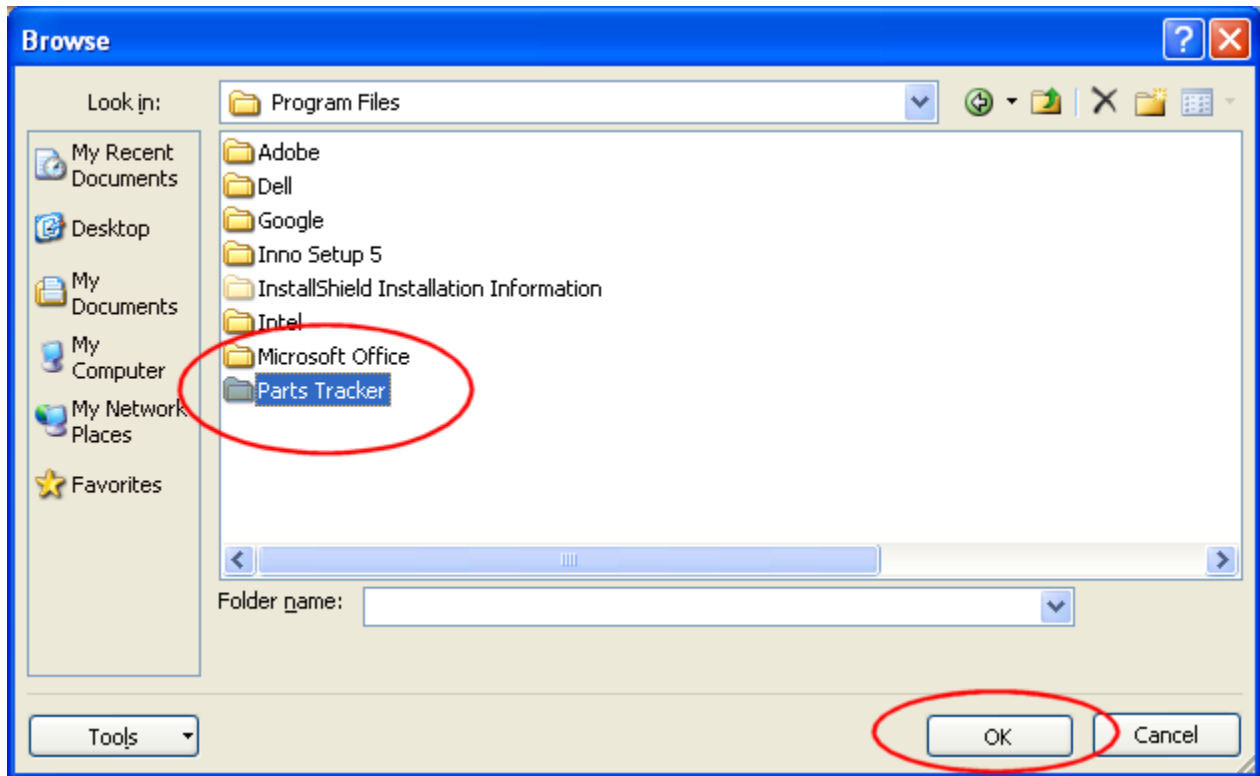
Press the **Add new location...** button.

The Trusted Location dialog is opened:



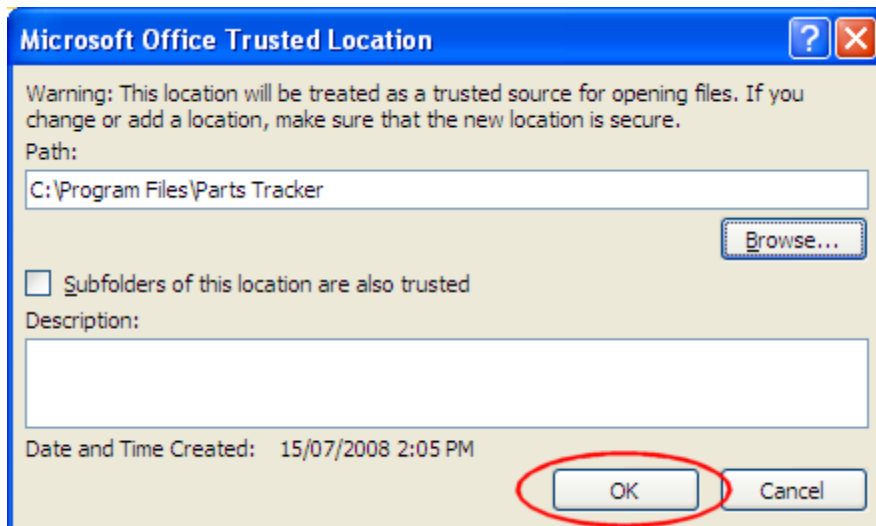
Press the **Browse...** button.

A folder browsing window opens:



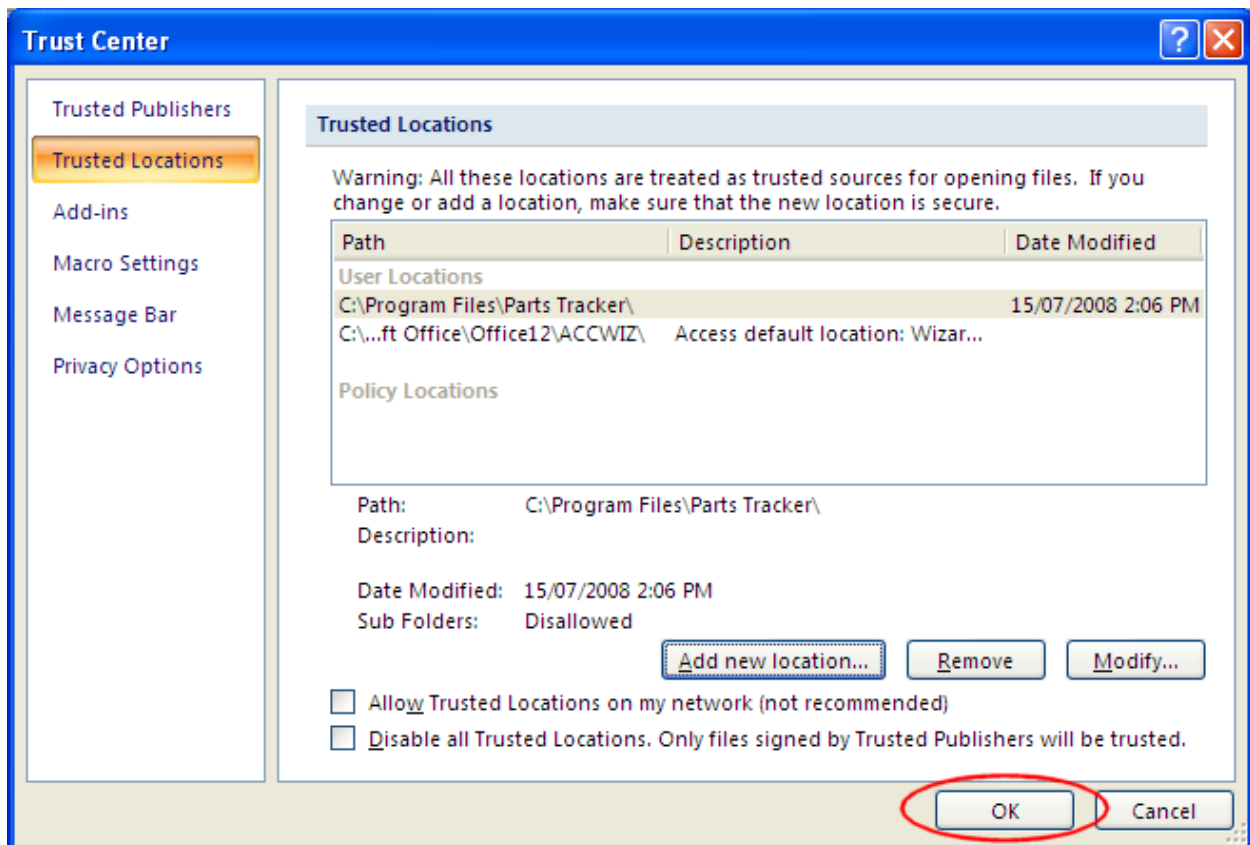
Locate the `C:\Program Files\Parts Tracker\` folder and press **OK**.

You are returned to the previous window, now with the Parts Tracker folder displayed:



Press the **OK** button.

The Trust Center window is shown now with the Parts Tracker folder listed in the trusted locations list:



Press the **OK** button.

You are then returned to the alert window:



First select the **Enable this content** option. Then press the **OK** button.

Parts Tracker will then start.

From now on, when you open Parts Tracker, the security message will not be displayed.
